BACK GROUND OF SURYA KIRAN PARENTS ASSOCIATION FOR THE WELFARE OF THE MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN, MACHERLA, PALNADU DISTRICT OF ANDHRA PRADESH.

THE SURYA KIRAN SPECIAL SCHOOL WAS ESTABLISHED IN YEAR 1992. IT SERVES AS A DAY CARE CENTER FOR IMPARTING SPECIAL EDUCATION TRAINING AND OFFERS OTHER THERAPEUTIC SERVICES.

In addition to the special school, we have started a Vocational Training-cum-production Center in 1994 with the assistance from National Institute for the Mentally Handicapped (NIMH). In 1994, we also started Residential Home for the Mentally Handicapped and home needs Training and Shopping Center.

At the SURYA KIRAN SPECIAL SCHOOL the special teachers plan Individualized Educational Program (EPS) for each child admitted and train them in the skill areas like self-help, motor, communication, cognitive, academic, socialization and pre-vocational. Academic, recreation, and socialization skill are imparted at school and parents are given guidance to train children in self-help skills, leisure time activities at Home.

Other than these, the children also participate in Yoga, music, arts and crafts, Drawing and other recreational activities. Our children regularly participate in Sports and games conducted at district, state and national level.



We regularly serve pre-school age children with disabilities through home based training and impart readiness skills in them in other way we make them ready for school entry. The services are provided through itinerant services.

The Surya Kiran Parents Association for the welfare of Mentally Handicapped (SURYA KIRAN PAMENCAP) is a non-profit, self-help voluntary organization registered under Public Societies Registration Act (bearing Regn. Nos. 352/92). The organization aims to provide comprehensive preventive, educative and rehabilitative services for the mentally handicapped and their families. The organization is located at Macherla as its head quarters and manages full fledged special school, residential hostel, a vocational trainingcum-production center, Home needs shopping center at Macherla and it also runs various rural extension centers in different parts of Palnadu District of Andhra Pradesh and Nalgonda District. Telangana State.. From the past Twenty Eight years, our organization had expanded its services deep in to the remote rural areas of Palnadu and Nalgonda districts of T.S. particularly Macherla, Piduguralla, Karampudi, and Nalgonda areas. It has made a tremendous impact on the lives of people with disabilities and their families. The community awareness programs initiated by us yielded great results and brought many persons with mental retardation and other disabilities under Surya Kiran Parents Association. Our catchment area has increased and new extension centers were opened at different parts of Palnadu Nalgonda Districts.

We serve all persons with mental retardation irrespective age, and severity free of cost. We also provide services to other children having various disabilities. Special teachers and a therapist from (Nalgonda) center visit the schools and train the volunteer's and Assistant Teachers particularly local youth and others persons interested in teaching children with mental retardation. We are marching ahead with constant encouragement and cooperation from parents, professionals, government and Non-Government organizations.



ANNUAL REPORT OF SPECIAL SCHOOL, RESIDENTIAL HOME AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE AND HOME NEEDS SHOPPING AND TRAINING CENTRE FOR THE MENTALLY HANDICAPPED, MACHERLA:

During the last reporting year between April 2022 to March 2023, Surya Kiran Parents Association for the Mentally Handicapped Children, Macherla center has spread its services in the few more remote rural areas of Palnadu & Nalgonda Districts of the Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. As a result of these special schools were opened to reach the unrecalled. Some of the significant achievements of our performance center wise are:

The Surya Kiran Special School was established in year 1992. It serves as a day care Center for imparting special education training and offers other therapeutic services. In addition to the special school, we have started a Vocational Training-cum-production Center in 1994 with the assistance from National Institute for the Mentally Handicapped (NIMH). In 1994, we also started Residential Home for the Mentally Handicapped and home needs Training and Shopping Center.

At the SURYA KIRAN SPECIAL SCHOOL the special teachers plan Individualized Educational Program (EPS) for each child admitted and train them in the skill areas like self-help, motor, communication, cognitive, academic, socialization and pre-vocational. THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING-CUM-PRODUCTION CENTRE

Was established with the aim of giving vocational training in suitable trades and gainful employment for adults with mental handicaps above sixteen years. A comprehensive assessment of the individual, his family and community is carried out for each trainee before deciding specific trade in which person is being trained. The trade is decided based on ability and aptitude of the student. The students are given training in envelop making, preparing washing powder, candle making, file making, liquid soap, phenyls and book binding. These items would be sold in the open market. Last year our sales were good and the demand for our products was growing in the area particularly among the offices, schools and grocery shops. We regularly conduct market survey in various areas and supply the products that are in great demand.

THE HOME NEEDS SHOPPING AND TRAINING CENTRE

Was established with the aim to provide training in handling money transactions, salesmanship etc. In a simulated setup. Once the students are trained the placement division of this unit attempts to tap open employment opportunities for trained students. Last year we have placed 8 students in different shops.

RESIDENTIAL HOME FOR THE MENTALLY HANDICAPPED

Was established with the aim of providing residential facility for outstation and serve handicapped persons. Preference is given to persons hailing from rural areas. A separate section is maintained for boys and girls. The inmates attend day care Center/prevocational Center during the day and spend their evenings and holidays in hostel.

Due to COVID 19, from the academic year 2022-2023 onwards, we have decided the limit in Hostel 40 only. Reaming 70 children are nearer to the Special School for Macherla and we are providing Transport facility to reach the School. It is expensive, but it is safe for them in this period.

THERAPISTS (NEW APPOINTMENT)

We fortunately got One Therapists for the year 2022-23 to the children.

He is working Full Time for the Special Children.

- j) To improve their functional ability to giving Vocational Training (To earn money)
- k) Provide Medical facilities by our Consultant Doctors.
- l), Provide benefits like Bus Pass, Railway Pass and wheel chairs and special equipments which they have need.
- m) Participating in Public Awareness Programs like, Sports Meet, Cultural activities, Sports and games.
- n) Provide picnics and other recreational activities in the whole academic year.
- o) There will be home visits, to make the parents to follow the Special Teacher or Social Worker instructions and suggestions at home to their children.
- p) To give confidence to the parents, their children are also able to live independently by giving our special services.
